The Grant for replacing the Dam was rejected by ODFW Engineering. Three Engineering representatives were on site early the week of June 5th. After discussions with them, they said they would provide CAF with a concept of what they think would be acceptable. The data was to be provided early the week of June 12th. The re-submittal date of the revised Grant is not

later than June 23rd. Award of the Grant is scheduled for mid to late July.

Per our Vice President, Tom Tostenson, the Grant he submitted for the fish passage was approved by the Watershed Council.

Fish tagging started June 2nd and was completed with approximately 26,000 fish tagged.

June 9, 2005

The meeting was called to order by President Art Kurz at 10:00AM. The minutes of the Board Meeting were approved.

Volunteer Coordinator; Kathy Moore said that we collected 47 fishing rods for free fishing day at Libby Pond.

Vice President; Tom Tostenson handed out the treasury report in Treasurer, Sue Kopec's absence. There are 26 yearly and 3 lifetime dues paid and 2 new members for the month. One ½ sponsors paid and Clear Sky was removed from the list. There is a positive cash flow for May. The grant from the Watershed Council has been approved to be used for fish passage, but the awarding of the grant is contingent upon the approval of the R&E grant.

Hatchery Consultant, Larry Schnider said that 26,400 fish have been tagged from the hatchery.

President; Art Kurz said that the final grant for R&E needs to be completed by June 23, 2005.

Board Member; Chris Underhill said the Cub Scouts will be taking a trip to Elk River Hatchery for free fishing Saturday.

The meeting was adjourned.
